

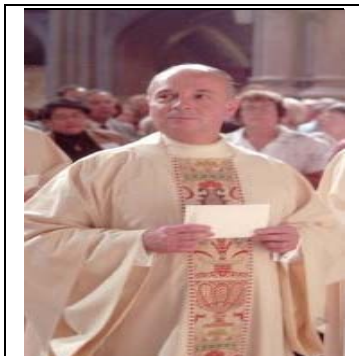

Fr. Cessario's topic is:

"Moral Theology in the Seminary

Father Romanus Cessario, a native of Boston, MA, was ordained for the Eastern Province of the Dominicans in 1971. After finishing theological studies at the Pontifical Faculty of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, where he earned a licentiate in sacred theology in 1972, Father Cessario served on the faculty and administration of Providence College (Providence, RI). He completed doctoral studies in theology at the University of Fribourg (Switzerland) under the late Colman O'Neill, O.P. and published his thesis, *Christian Satisfaction in Aquinas*, in 1982. A revised version, *The Godly Image* (St. Bede's Press/Fordham University Press), appeared in 1990. He also holds the M.A. in philosophy from St. Stephen's College (Dover, MA). In 1979, Father Cessario began teaching at the Dominican House of Studies in Washington, where he served as Academic Dean from 1979 to 1987. Since 1988, he has lectured in both the United States and Europe. In the Fall of 1995, Father Cessario joined the faculty of St. John's Seminary, Brighton, Massachusetts, where he currently serves as professor of systematic theology. Father Cessario has published articles in several areas of dogmatic and moral theology as well as on the history of Thomism.
